

## **CWEC SERVICE AWARD**

CWEC awards the CWEC Service Award, worth \$2000, every two years. The CWEC Service Award is given to recognize an individual's contribution to the status of women in the economics profession. Meritorious service can consist of (but is not limited to) exemplary service or achievement, professional mentoring, or research that advances understanding of women's advancement in the economics profession

### ***TERMS FOR THE CWEC SERVICE AWARD***

CWEC awards the CWEC Service Award to an economist judged by the selection committee to have furthered the status of women in the economics profession, through example, achievements, increasing our understanding of how women can advance in the economics profession, or mentoring other.

Nominations are open, and shall normally consist of a nomination letter, CV, and two or more supporting letters, with preferably at least one from a mentee. The nomination letters should be geared toward examples of how the nominee has fulfilled the criteria of the award, not necessarily through academic achievement alone. The call for nominations and the nomination deadline will be posted on the CEA and/or CWEC website and may also be circulated via e-mail.

Nominees may be of any gender or sex but must have spent a significant amount of their career in Canada. The selection committee has leeway on deciding the definition of "significant amount of time".

The selection committee, made up of at least three members, will be selected by the CWEC chair. The selection committee, will automatically retain and consider applications for the following two award cycles. However, they will also consider new material provided for the nominee during subsequent cycles.

The committee will report to the chair on its criteria and provide an award citation that will appear in the CEA newsletter and on the website of CWEC. The Committee may interpret these terms with a modest amount of flexibility, and reserves the right to not award this award in any given year.

The prize will normally be presented at the Annual General Meeting or luncheon of CWEC.
